Permission to participate

• Rule 5(1) of the Inquiry Rules 2006: "The chairman may designate a person as a core participant at any time during the course of the inquiry, provided that person consents to being so designated."

• Sec 11 of Inquiries into Fatal Accidents and Sudden Deaths etc (Scotland) Act 2016

Differences

• Issues of public concern which can be explored- unrestricted at Public Inquiry

• Relative infrequency of Public Inquiries

• Government initiated process

Permission for line of questioning

• Rule 10 (1), (4) and (5)

• Only counsel to inquiry can ask questions unless permission granted to legal representative of core participant by chairman



Warning letters

• Can be sent to those who have been, or may be, criticised during the inquiry proceedings or in the inquiry report

• Rules 13- 16



• Greater degree of control by chairman

• Terms of reference



• Unrestricted in issues of concern which can be explored

• Government initiated process

• Control and management power of chairman



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
